professional ethics



3) Teachers should discharge their responsibilities in accordance with the established rules outlined by the higher authorities and adhere to the conditions of contract.


 Teachers should refrain from responding to unnecessary political motivations as these ruin the sanctity and smooth progress of an educational institution.

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
